    - i. Rec CPR (Subcommittee 2)
      - Recreation is requesting \$49,800 to expand its CPR/AED/First Aid and Narcan training program, offering 87 fully subsidized classes for students, Resident Advisors, and frontline staff
      - SFAC argues that RAs lack professional health training but are
        protected under the CA Good Samaritan Law if acting
        non-negligently, which provides emergency response guidelines,
        while Recreation highlights concerns about performing CPR, the
        law's "no compensation" clause potentially excluding compensated
        RAs, and the benefit of certification for confidence and
        competence.
      - The majority of seats should be reserved for students whose fees are funding this program.
      - Strong interest from ResLife, HDH and Health Student Organizations
    - ii. Rec Beach in a Box (Subcommittee 4)
      - Recreation is requesting \$12,000-15,000 to povide beach equipment/games for students to promote engagement at the beach

- (i.e. volleyballs, beach chairs, spikeball etc.). Rec will cover the cost of staffing.
- Location changed to up land next to surfboard storage. Box will
  not be directly on the beach because due to the nature of tidal
  waves reaching high, a steel box won't be sustainable
- Concerns: 3 student workers will spend ~1 hour to drag all the inventory down to the beach with wagons, Cleaning/Maintenance of supplies, Service hours
