5. Post Interview Score Review
  - a. Subcommittee #2 Presentation: Athletics - International Student Fan Fast
    - i. Students will come to the game with a tailgate function, the tailgate will be the bulk of the event, will showcase all of the sports, target international students, in the past did this event but small amount of students, bigger scale this time, partnering with ISEO
    - ii. Last time it was 50 students, thinking of engaging in “American Sports.” Will meet with international scholar athletes
    - iii. Asking ~20k (9k for food truck, 10k to giveaways / entertainment (dj / photo booth)
    - iv. Partial funding will decrease the amount of students invited. Looking for a donor for the next year.
    - v. Target audience is international students, going to market with TWOW, email, social media, and campus digital displays, expect 1000 attendance
    - vi. Most likely during TWOW, looking for student input for what sporting event.
    - vii. Maybe start in October when more competitive games
    - viii. Scholar athletes will explore the rules of the game, will have chance for students to play / practice the sport
    - ix. This event is open to everyone, and will not turn away other students. Increased community
    - x. Doing different events like Korean Kpop event, work closely with ISEO
    - xi. Since graduate students do NOT pay athletic fees, discounted tickets for graduate students. Soccer is free to all students however.
    - xii. Anything in Liontree is discounted for graduates students since they do not pay athletic fee
    - xiii. Follow up question: can they target international graduate students as well.

    - i. 3 components, care fellows, care installations, and culminating event

- ii. \$599 per person for 3 years, can each teach 25 students, 500 QPR gate keepers, care installations are popup around campus, low barrier, peer to peer, break town stigma
- iii. Student fellow makes less load on pro-staff.
- iv. Timeline and marketing, starting in summer of next year, recruit care fellow, start trainings, do workshops, winter is the big event, more workshops and pass out booklets,
- v. Culminating event, turn everything learned, similar to Student Wellness Fest
- vi. 107 faculty members enrolled in this program, students showed interest
- vii. One pop up per college, each one handful of hours, aiming for 20+ student per hour
- viii. Past event received positive feedback
- ix. Each fellow gets 25 booklets to train 25 students, in total around 500 students.
- x. How do you plan on receiving funding in the future?
  - 1. People will endorse if this program if successful
- xi. 8 hour training session
- xii. Will have to upkeep booklet, able to teach more and more students
- xiii. More students will know of strategies to deal with distress
- xiv. QPR training for critical student leader if given partial funding
- xv. Council gave good feedback
- xvi. Funding is going to training. Pop-ups are not very expensive.
- xvii. Colleges already have support for students, how would this be different?

  - i. Moved to next week
- d. Subcommittee #3 Presentation: Athletics - Battle of the Kings Auxiliary Event
  - i. UCSD vs LMU, both mascots are “kings,” everyone who is turned away will be allowed to go to EFA for a watch party.
  - ii. First week of fall quarter.
  - iii. Estimated 500-1000 students (typically amount turned away)
  - iv. EFA is 10k to rent out, the other 10k is going for foam crown, raffle, food truck, photo booth, and more
  - v. Market it similar to UnOlympic
  - vi. Will have staff and signage to guide people, have had previous watch parties at Dirt Birds, was successful
  - vii. Food is free for students at EFA, some food will go to aquatic center
  - viii. Graduate students because it's a watch party, not a game.
  - ix. Warren Council was supportive, many students who did attend have never been to a game since, so this might help
  - x. Marketing will be very important for an event like this.
  - xi. Going to push for incoming students so they become familiar with the athletic program

  - i. Big celebration for West Coast Conference membership, more funding available
